Re: Mr. AGEISHI, Kumio, M/63

This is to recap the main points that we have gone through during our consultation on 20-2-2012. We agreed that the jaw bone is very atrophic in the lower right jaw. Implant placement over that region requires prior extensive bone grafting. We also agreed that the lower right first premolar, lower right lateral incisor, lower left first molar and upper right first molar should be extracted. The surgical risk of the bone grafting and potential damage to the nerve leading to lower lip numbness is significant. After balancing all the risks, we have decided to go for the non-grafting option. The treatment plan is summarized as below:

- 1. Dental clearance in the lower jaw
- 2. Immediate placement of four dental implants in lower jaw with immediate grafting of bony defects
- 3. Immediate working impression to construct temporary bridge in lower jaw
- 4. Extraction of upper right first molar with socket preservation
- 5. Fitting of Temporary bridge in lower jaw one week after the surgery
- 6. Construction of final bridge in lower jaw four months after surgery
- 7. Placement of dental implant to replace upper right first molar

The quotation of the fees involved was listed as below:

The fee to be paid at the visit of the surgery would be \$115,000. The balance of \$56,000 for the lower bridge would be paid 5 months after the first surgery when the final bridge is fitted. As for the upper right first molar, \$14,000 would be paid at the time of placement of the implant, that is about 4 months after the first surgery. The remaining \$14,000 would be paid when the final crown is finished.
